## AGILITY POINT SCORE AWARD

## RULES:

- The accrual period will be from competitions conducted 1<sup>st</sup> February to 31<sup>st</sup> October inclusive.
- To be eligible, applicants must be financial members of NSDTC and must have trained regularly at NSDTC in Agility during the accrual period. Applicants must consider NSDTC to be their <u>primary</u> training club for Agility.
- Presentation will be made at the NSDTC Christmas Party.
- The Chief Instructor (Agility) will tally each competing months' scores sheets throughout the year and submit the winner's details by 7<sup>th</sup> November.
- Winners of the Agility Point Score Award will have their details engraved on the perpetual trophy (to be retained in the NSDTC clubhouse) and will also receive an individual memento.

## SELECTION CRITERIA:

The Agility Point Score Award will be determined by a point score system.

The point score competition will be held on the last Saturday of the month at NSDTC unless a non training day ie long weekends, council's use of the grounds, severe weather conditions etc.

Participants will receive the following points:

- 4 points for 1<sup>st</sup> place
- 3 points for 2<sup>nd</sup> place
- 2 points for 3<sup>rd</sup> place
- 1 point for non-placing qualifying score

In the event of a tie, the winner of the Point Score Award will be determined by a count back of comparative course times, the least comparative time to be the winner.
